Doors Opening in Cuba: A Mission of Hope and Transformation

"I thank my God every time I remember you. In all my prayers for all of you, I always pray with joy because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now." — Philippians 1:3-5

Dear Friends and Supporters: We are writing to you today with hearts full of gratitude. **Thank you.** Because of your prayers and generosity, our recent mission to Cuba was more than just a trip; it was a move of God and historic. We are still filled with the energy of what we witnessed on the ground. There is a spiritual awakening happening in Cuba that isn't making the evening news, but it is transforming eternity.

The news focuses on economic struggles of the island, something else is happening that the headlines miss: **The Spirit of God is igniting hearts with courage and hope.**

Celebrating What God Has Done

Our recent trip was highly fruitful, proving once again that the Gospel opens doors that no man can shut. Together, we witnessed:

- **A Historic First:** We shared the Gospel with over **500 children** during three "Festival of Hope" events. Miraculously, one of these was held inside a communist state-controlled school—a first for a Christian program.
- **63 Professions of Faith:** Through house-to-house evangelism alongside four local partner churches, 63 individuals surrendered their lives to Christ.
- **Meeting Essential Needs:** We provided humanitarian relief bags (filled with rice, beans, and essentials) to families facing severe shortages.
- **Strengthening Families:** 186 people attended our "Art of Marriage" conferences, equipping couples to build Christ-centered homes.

Looking Ahead: Our 2026 Mission Calendar

The momentum is building, and we are committed to continuing this work. We have three strategic trips planned for 2026, and we are asking you to join us in **March, July, and November.**

Our next trip is tentative **March 14 – 21, 2026**, where our team will:

- **Train Pastors** in biblical doctrine and disciple-making.
- **Deliver Aid** to families recovering from a devastating hurricane and the ongoing economic crisis.
- **Launch Sports Ministry** through soccer programs to reach the local community.
- **Host Worship Nights** and marriage conferences to provide spiritual refreshment.

The men responded extremely well to all the special teaching moments. Your fervent prayers and intercession is what makes these moments so good as we know we wrestle against the principalities of darkness. God's continued and richest blessings to all of you.

We are all praising God for a successful and fruitful week of ministry. We wrapped up our last day of ministry at SFRC with our drummer, Marco doing the teaching from 9-11AM with nineteen in attendance who received the word gladly. Rev. Tony and Rev. Ed taught the 1-3PM spot with twenty three men in attendance. What was interesting is that Ed's message was unpacking Psalm 23, and there were twenty three men in attendance. More importantly, eleven men responded by receiving Christ after Rev. Tony delivered his message followed by an alter call.

We also had three powerful testimonies, one by a man who was given a 33 year sentence after being convicted for armed robbery and while incarcerated, truly repented and got serious with the Lord. After much prayer and fasting his sentence which initially was 33 years, was reduced to 25. This brother continued to pray and fast, resulting in the Lord allowing his sentence to be reduced then to 10 years, then to 5 years, then 3 1/2 years. Now our brother in Christ, only has an 18 month sentence and desires to enter into full-time ministry focusing on the incarcerated!
